COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 51, L. D. 52, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Trailers Being Securely Fastened."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 29, §1755, amended. The last sentence of section
1755 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the
following new paragraph enacted in place thereof:

Every trailer, semitrailer or vehicle being towed shall,
in addition to the tow bar or coupling device, have a safety
chain or steel cable to prevent break away from the towing vehicle.
Each chain or steel cable shall be made of not less than 1/4 of
an inch wire. This provision shall not apply to truck-tractor and
semitrailer units equipped with fifth wheel mechanism.'
