AN ACT Relating to Trailers Being Securely Fastened.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1755, amended. The last sentence of section 1755 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

A trailer ~~having more than 2 wheels~~ shall be connected to the towing vehicle by at least one chain or cable, in addition to the hitch bar, of sufficient strength to hold the trailer on a hill if the hitch bar becomes disconnected, or shall be provided with some other adequate holding device.
