RESOLVE, to Reimburse Bernard J. Kinney of Winthrop for Well Damage by Highway Maintenance.

Bernard J. Kinney; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$2,500 to be paid to Bernard J. Kinney of Winthrop for salt damage to his well caused by maintenance on Route No. 133 in Winthrop.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The land Mr. Kinney owns on Route No. 133 lies below road level. Salt used on Route No. 133 drains onto Mr. Kinney's land causing damage to his water supply. It will be necessary for him to drill another well on the other side of the road where he has some elevated land.
