COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 60, L. D. 62, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Authority to Regulate Motor Vehicle Speeds."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting after the stricken out word and punctuation "jointly," in the 7th, 10th and 14th lines (5th, 8th and 12th lines in L.D. 62) the underlined punctuation and words ',with the consent and approval of the Chief of the <u>Maine State Police</u>,'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting after the stricken out word and punctuation "jointly," in the 9th line (8th line in L.D. 62) the underlined punctuation and words ',with the consent and approval of the Chief of the Maine State Police,'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 by inserting after the stricken out word "determine" in the 5th line (4th line in L.D. 62) the underlined punctuation and words ',with the consent and approval of the Chief of the Maine State Police,'; and by inserting after the stricken out word and punctuation "jointly," in the 9th line (8th line in L.D. 62) the underlined punctuation and words ',with the consent and approval of the Chief of the Maine State Police,'

Further amend said Bill in section 4 by inserting after the stricken out word and punctuation "jointly," in the 7th line (5th line in L.D. 62) the underlined punctuation and words ', with the consent and approval of the Chief of the Maine State Police,'
