STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Obedience to Police Officers in Controlling Traffic.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T 29, § 906, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 906, to read as follows:

§ 906. Obedience to police officers

No person shall willfully fail or refuse to comply with any lawful order or direction of any police officer invested by law with authority to direct, control or regulate traffic.
