## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Dividing the State of Maine into Presidential Election Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Apportionment of Presidential Elector Districts.** For the purpose of choosing presidential electors, the State is divided into 4 Presidential Elector Districts, and each district shall be entitled to one elector to be chosen in the **manner prescribed by the Constitution** and laws of the State, as follows:

First District: Shall consist of Senatorial Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, 9 and 10.

Second District: Shall consist of Senatorial Districts 5, 6, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, and 18.

Third District: Shall consist of Senatorial Districts 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 28 and 29.

Fourth District: Shall consist of Senatorial Districts 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 30, 31 and 32.
