RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for the Perambulation of the Maine-New Hampshire Boundary Line.

Perambulation of Maine-New Hampshire boundary line; funds for. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$7,000 to carry out the provisions of the public laws of 1937, chapter 179.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The perambulation of the Maine-New Hampshire boundary as provided for in the above Act is now due, and the above amount is estimated as the cost to the State of Maine.
