AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Aid Sweetser Children's Home of Saco.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sweetser Children's Home; appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Sweetser Children's Home located in Saco the sum of \$45,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 and \$45,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 to help defray the costs of providing treatment at the home for emotionally disturbed children who are wards of the State.
