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**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Robert Sweet of Lincoln Center for Well Damage  
Resulting from Use of Salt on Route 2.**

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**Robert Sweet; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Robert Sweet of Lincoln Center the sum of \$1,144.34 for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to his well as a result of the use of salt on Route 2 in Lincoln Center and the drainage which polluted such well.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Sweet's well was completely damaged by salt because of drainage on Route 2 in Lincoln Center. The estimated damages as paid by Mr. Sweet are:

New well and casing—94 ft.	\$796.30
New Pump	284.24
Labor and tax	63.80
