COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 89, L. D. 98, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Use of Nomination Papers for Council or School  
Board Membership in Town of Falmouth."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following (same  
in L. D. 98):

'Referendum; effective date; certificate to Secretary of  
State. This Act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of  
the Legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission  
to the legal voters of the Town of Falmouth at the next regular  
town meeting.

The town clerk shall reduce the subject matter of this Act  
to the following question:

"Shall the Act Relating to Use of Nomination Papers for  
Council or School Board Membership in Town of Falmouth, passed by  
the 104th Legislature, be accepted?"

The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed  
against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.

This Act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately  
upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting at  
said meeting; provided that the total number of votes cast for and  
against the acceptance of this Act at said meeting equaled or  
exceeded 20% of the total vote cast for all candidates for Governor  
in said town at the next preceding gubernatorial election.

The result of the vote shall be declared by the municipal  
officers of the Town of Falmouth and due certificate thereof shall
