# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Use of Nomination Papers for Council or School Board Membership in Town of Falmouth.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1961, c. 172, Art. VIII, § 802, amended. Section 802 of Article VIII of chapter 172 of the private and special laws of 1961 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 802. Nomination. Any qualified elector of the town may be nominated for the council or school board only by the use of nomination papers in accordance with the laws of the State of Maine.
