STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Use of Artificial Lights for Lighting Game.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2465, amended. Section 2465 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 20 of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 2465. Use of artificial lights for lighting game

The use of artificial lights between $\frac{1}{2}$ hour after sunset and $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before sunrise to illuminate, jack, locate, attempt to locate or show up wild birds or wild animals shall be unlawful from October 12th to December 5th during any open season on deer, except as provided in section 2354, and section 2358, subsection 4.
