STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Revocation of Certain Licenses Under Fish and Game Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 2302, amended. The first paragraph of section 2302 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The commissioner shall revoke the hunting license of any person who is convicted of violating sections 2353, 2451 to 2455, 2458, 2462, 2464, 2467 and 2801 for a period of one year from the date when he is notified of said conviction.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, § 2302, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 2302 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 12 of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed, as follows:

The commissioner may suspend licenses held by any person who has appealed from a sentence imposed upon an alleged violation of chapter 301 to 335, or Title 32, chapter 65, or of any rules and regulations adopted by the commissioner pursuant hereto. Such suspension shall apply only to the particular activity in which the licensee was engaged at the time of the alleged violation.
