## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Chiropractic Services for Injured Employee Under Workmen's Compensation Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 52, amended. The first sentence of section 52 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 2 of chapter 374 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

An employee sustaining a personal injury by accident arising out of and in the course of his employment or is disabled by occupational disease shall be entitled to reasonable and proper medical, surgical and hospital services, nursing, medicines, and mechanical, surgical aids, as needed, paid for by the employer; and such employee should he voluntarily so choose shall be entitled to chiropractic services, as needed, paid for by the employer.
