IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Property Tax Exemption of Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 36, § 653, sub-§ 1, ¶ D-1, amended. The last sentence of paragraph D-1 of subsection 1 of section 653 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 144 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed, as follows:

~~A veteran receiving exemption under this paragraph shall not receive exemption under paragraph C.~~

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 36, § 653, sub-§ 1, ¶ J, additional. Subsection 1 of section 653 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph J, to read as follows:

J. No person shall be entitled to property tax exemption under more than one paragraph of this subsection.
