STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide for a Statistician in the Department of Agriculture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 7 § 2, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 2 Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

He shall gather statistics of information concerning agriculture and publish the same annually.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 7, § 2, amended. Section 2 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, as follows:

The commissioner shall appoint, subject to the Personnel Law, a statistician who shall collect, compile, systematize and publish statistical information concerning agriculture.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of \$10,250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 and the sum of \$15,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
