AN ACT Relating to Fishing in Narraguagus River, Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2551, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 2551 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 20-A of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Except at Upper Dam in Richardsontown (T4 R1) at the outlet of Mooselookmeguntic Lake in Oxford County, at Middle Dam in T C at the outlet of Lower Richardson Lake in Oxford County and at East Outlet Dam in Sapling (T1 R7) in Somerset County and in Big Squaw Mountain in Piscataquis County at the outlet of Moosehead Lake, the fishway and the area within 50 feet of any part of these fishways shall be closed to fishing at all times and except at Woodland Dam and Grand Falls Powerhouse Dam on the St. Croix River in the Town of Baileyville, the area within 100 feet of the mouth of the fishway shall be closed to fishing at all times and except at the so-called ice control dam on the Narraguagus River in the Town of Cherryfield, the area within 100 feet of the dam shall be closed to fishing at all times.
