AN ACT Relating to Amortization Requirements of Bond Issue for Women's
Dormitory at Farmington State College of the University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L. 1967, c. 224, Chapter B. § 2, amended. The last sentence of section 2 of Chapter B of chapter 224 of the private and special laws of 1967 is amended to read as follows:

The rates for room charged and collected for the amortization of the principal of and the interest on the bonds issued with the authority of chapter B of this Act shall apply also to all of the Farmington State College of the University of Maine dormitories operated by the state board (now operated by the University of Maine), and shall be established to take effect not later than the beginning of the college or school year next following the date of ratification of chapter B of this Act, and the fees and rentals so charged and collected also shall be pledged to the amortization of principal and payment of interest on the bonds issued under the authority of chapter B of this Act.
