STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Daily Limit of Trout Taken from Inland Waters of
Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 2553, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 2553 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 142 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

No person shall take, catch kill or have in possession more than 12 fish of the salmon, ~~trout~~ togue or black bass species during any one day of any open season, from any or all of the inland waters of Aroostook County except as provided for by rules and regulations of the department under section 1960.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, § 2553, amended. The first paragraph of section 2553 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 142 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding at the end the following:

No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession more than 15 fish of the trout species during any one day of any open season, from any or all of the inland waters of Aroostook County except as provided for by rules and regulations of the department under section 1960.
