COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 119, L.D. 135, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Safety Equipment on Boats Operated on Waters of the
State."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated paragraph
"B." by inserting in the first line (same in L.D.), after the
underlined word "watercraft" the underlined words and punctuation
', except canoes,'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part
designated paragraph "C." and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'C. Operator means the person who operates or who has
charge of the navigation, use or operation of a watercraft.

D. The operator shall be responsible to see that water-
craft are equipped as specified in this section before
operating said watercraft on the waters of this State.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective
January 1, 1970.'
