SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 119, L.D. 135, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Safety Equipment on Boats Operated on Waters of the State."

Amend said Bill in paragraph A of subsection 1 by adding at the end of the first sentence, before the period, the following underlined words and punctuation: ' , except that motorboats driven by machinery of 10 horsepower or less and in operation on the inland waters between the hours of sunset and sunrise must display at least a single illuminated white light, capable of showing all around the horizon, so as to make its presence known to all other watercraft in every direction which are within a reasonable distance, provided further that nothing herein shall prohibit the display of lights as required by federal laws in lieu of the single white light'
