COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 120, L. D. 136, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Violating the Laws Dealing with Certain Birds."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined  
paragraph (same in L. D. 136) and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions  
of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50  
and in addition thereto by a fine of \$25 for each bird illegally  
killed, taken or possessed, and such fines shall not be suspended,  
or by imprisonment for not less than 30 nor more than 90 days,  
or by both fine and imprisonment.'
