STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT To permit a Teacher to be a Selectman or a City Council Member.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2251, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 2251 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 247 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, to read as follows:

This subsection shall not prohibit a member of a city council or board of selectmen from renewing a teaching contract with the municipality in which he holds such office.
