IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Operation of Motorcycles While Learning to Drive.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 537, amended. The last paragraph of section 537 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 303 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

No person while operating a motorcycle or motor driven cycle under the authority of a learner's permit shall carry any other person thereon, nor shall a person operate a motorcycle or motor driven cycle on a learner's permit other than during daylight hours.
