## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Surrender of Motor Vehicle Instruction Permits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 532, amended. Section 532 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by chapter 207 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

All such instruction permits shall automatically expire when the holder has successfully passed a complete examination and has been issued a temporary license. Such permits shall thereupon be surrendered to the Secretary of State.
