STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT to Exempt Television Sets and Musical Instruments from Property Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 36, § 655, sub-§ 1, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection 1 of section 655 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
 - **A.** The household furniture, excluding including television sets and musical instrutments, of each person in any one household; and his wearing apparel, farming utensils and mechanics' tools necessary for his business.
