RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Ramp and Docking Facilities at Long Island Plantation.

Ramp and Docking facilities at Long Island Plantation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$30,000 to Long Island Plantation for a ramp (gangway) for passengers, vehicles and heavy equipment and to complete the docking facilities at Long Island Plantation in order to provide adequate ferry service to and from said plantation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Adequate ferry service is vitally needed to and from Long Island Plantation. Such service at the present time is not sufficient to safeguard persons and property.
