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**RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Ramp and Docking Facilities at Long Island Plantation.**

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**Ramp and Docking facilities at Long Island Plantation. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$30,000 to Long Island Plantation for a ramp (gangway) for passengers, vehicles and heavy equipment and to complete the docking facilities at Long Island Plantation in order to provide adequate ferry service to and from said plantation.

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

Adequate ferry service is vitally needed to and from Long Island Plantation. Such service at the present time is not sufficient to safeguard persons and property.
