AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Fishing in Brooks and Streams.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2552, sub-§ 4, amended. Subsection 4 of section 2552 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 31 of chapter 404 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

4. All fish except black bass in brooks and streams. There shall be an open season for all fish except black bass in brooks and streams in waters free of ice from April 1st to ~~August 15th~~ **September 30th**, except in Aroostook County the open season shall be from May 1st to ~~August 15th~~ **September 30th**.
