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**AN ACT Relating to Cutting of Trees Near Waterways and Highways.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 17, § 2508, additional.** Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2508, to read as follows:

**§ 2508. Cutting trees**

It is unlawful to cut down trees within a distance of 150 feet of any brook or stream which is 30 inches or more in width, or within 150 feet of any river, pond, lake or highway, other than the selective cutting of trees with a diameter of 12 inches approximately 4 feet from the ground.
