STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Designating Landlocked Salmon as the State of Maine Fish.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 1, § 212, additional. Title 1 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 212, to read as follows:

§ 212. State fish

The state fish shall be the landlocked salmon (Salmo salar).
