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**AN ACT** Providing for Sessions of the District Court for Central Hancock at Bucksport.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 4, § 153, sub-§ 11, amended.** The 2nd sentence of subsection 11 of section 153 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows: The District Court for Central Hancock shall be held at Ellsworth, **except that one session per week may be held at Bucksport at the discretion of the presiding judge.**
