IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 6th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Hancock County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Hancock County: County Commissioners, \$\frac{\pi}{1,\pm 50}\$\$ \$1,600; chairman, \$1,900; clerk of courts, \$\frac{\pi}{4,250}\$\$ \$4,750; deputy clerk of courts, \$\frac{\pi}{3,100}\$; county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, \$\frac{\pi}{2,\frac{\pi}{50}}\$\$ \$3,500; sheriff, \$\frac{\pi}{5,000}\$ \$5,700; register of deeds, \$\frac{\pi}{4,250}\$\$ \$4,750; judge of probate, \$\frac{\pi}{4,250}\$\$ \$4,750.
