**AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of Hancock County.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended.** The 6th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Hancock County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

**Hancock County:** County Commissioners, ~~\$1,450~~ \$1,600; chairman, \$1,900; clerk of courts, ~~\$4,250~~ \$4,750; deputy clerk of courts, \$3,100; county attorney, \$5,000; county treasurer, ~~\$2,850~~ \$3,500; sheriff, ~~\$5,000~~ \$5,700; register of deeds, ~~\$4,250~~ \$4,750; judge of probate, ~~\$4,500~~ \$4,750; register of probate, ~~\$4,250~~ \$4,750.
