**RESOLVE**, to Reimburse Russell S. Leonard of Wells for Injuries Sustained  
in Automobile Accident with Deer.

**Russell S. Leonard; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,500 to reimburse Russell S. Leonard of Wells for injuries sustained in an automobile accident with a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Leonard of Wells was injured on November 11, 1967 while riding in a car on Route 202 in Buxton when an 8-point buck jumped from the woods smashing into the vehicle. His injuries consisted of a badly compounded fracture of the upper tibia, a fracture of the lower tibia and a fractured fibia. All fractures are in the right leg. He will be in a hip cast for some time and carries no insurance. Mr. Leonard feels that any financial provision that the State might make would be of great help to him.
