RESOLVE, to Reimburse Norman Ouellette of Canaan for Well Damage from Highway Maintenance.

Norman Ouellette; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$500 to be paid to Norman Ouellette of Canaan, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage to his dug well caused by use of salt on Route 2 in Canaan.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The dug well belonging to Norman Ouellette of Canaan is used for drinking water by 2 families. The well is 20 feet deep and is located 35 feet from the highway.
