### AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Canada Lynx.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 2358, sub-§ 1, amended. The 3rd paragraph from the end of subsection 1 of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 21 of chapter 404 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

There shall be no open season on sable (marten) and Canada lynx...

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, § 2358, sub-§ 1, amended. The next to the last paragraph of subsection 1 of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 22 of chapter 404 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

The open season on all other wild or fur-bearing animals, excepting bobcats, loupcervier, canada lynx and beaver shall be from November 1st of each calendar year to February 15th in the next following year.
