COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 167, L. D. 206, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Lack of Privity as a Defense in Action Against

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting after the word
"Seller" the words 'or Supplier'

Further amend said Bill in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.)
by striking out the underlined words "or seller" and inserting
in place thereof the underlined punctuation and words ',seller
or supplier'; and by striking out in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.)
the underlined words "or seller" and inserting in place thereof the
underlined punctuation and words ',seller or supplier'; and by
striking out in the 11th line (9th line in L.D.) the underlined
words "or seller" and inserting in place thereof the underlined
punctuation and words ',seller or supplier'
