AN ACT Relating to the Exemption of School Bus Operations from Regulation by the Public Utilities Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 1642, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 1642 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

1. **School bus.** The operation of a school bus as defined in Title 29, section 2011, when such school bus is engaged in transportation ~~authorized by Title 29, sections 1285 and 3561,~~ of children to and from school and to and from any school sponsored activity when such school-sponsored activity is performed as part of a continuing contract to transport children to and from school sessions. Such transportation may include a reasonable number of chaperones formally designated as such by school authorities.
