STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Reports of the Managers of the Maine Industrial Building Authority and the Maine Recreation Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 10, § 751, sub-§ 4-A, additional. Section 751 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 4-A, to read as follows:
- 4-A. Reports to Legislature. Make to the Joint Legislative Standing Committee on Industrial and Recreational Development when the Legislature is in session and to the Legislative Research Committee when the Legislature is not in session a monthly report documenting the actions of the authority, and such other reports as either committee may request;
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 10, § 5051, sub-§ 4-A, additional. Section 5051 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 495 of the public laws of 1965, is amended by adding a new subsection 4-A, to read as follows:
- 4-A. Reports to Legislature. Make to the Joint Legislative Standing Committee on Industrial and Recreational Development when the Legislature is in session and to the Legislative Research Committee when the Legislature is not in session a monthly report documenting the actions of the authority, and such other reports as either committee may request.
