STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Possession of Firearms in the Southern Hunting Zone.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2353, amended. The 8th paragraph from the end of section 2353 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt deer after he has killed one during the open season of that calendar year.

It shall be further provided that in the Southern Zone it shall be unlawful for any person to have in possession any firearm, except a shotgun, or any shotgun ammunition larger than No. 2 shot in the fields, forests or upon the waters or ice of the State in such Southern Zone.
