RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing on Certain Lakes in Penobscot and Piscataquis Counties.

Ice fishing on certain lakes; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to regulate the following lakes open to ice fishing for smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until March 31st, with night fishing permitted, 3 hooks per line permitted; such hooks to be not less than 4 inches apart:

Penobscot County: Millinocket Lake—T. 1, R. 8; T. 2, R. 8, W.E.L.S.

Piscataquis County: Ambajejus Lake—T. 1, R. 9, W.E.L.S.

Pemadumcook Lake, T. 1, R. 9 and 10.

Twin Lakes, North Indian Purchase 3 and 4, T. 1, R. 9.
