STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Poll Taxes Paid to Caswell Plantation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 36, § 1421, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 1421 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Poll taxes collected by the State Tax Assessor from the residents of Connor in the year in which the biennial state election is held shall be paid by the State to Caswell Plantation.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act as it applies to Caswell Plantation shall become effective for the year 1969 and thereafter.
