STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Cost of Replacement Motor Vehicles as Damages in Civil Actions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 14, § 1454, additional. Title 14 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1454, to read as follows:

§ 1454. Cost of replacement motor vehicles

In any action where recovery is sought for the destruction or damage of a motor vehicle, the owner of such motor vehicle shall recover reasonable rental costs, actually expended, for a replacement motor vehicle during such time as the destroyed or damaged motor vehicle could not be operated.
