IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Entry Fee Under Small Claims Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 14, § 7453, amended. The last sentence of section 7453 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The plaintiff or his authorized attorney shall at the same time pay an entry fee of \$3 \$5, from which the clerk is authorized to expend the costs of giving notice to defendant and the remainder to be retained by the court as costs.
