HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 206, L.D. 256, Bill, "An Act Relating to Age of Dogs for Licensing Purposes."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 7, §3401, amended. Section 3401 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

§3401. Lists of all dogs; returns

Assessors of taxes shall include in their inventories lists of all dogs 4 6 months old or over owned or kept by any inhabtitants on the first day of January, setting the number and sex thereof opposite the names of their respective owners or keepers, and shall make returns to the clerks of their respective municipalities on or before the first day of June following.

Sec. 4. R. S., T. 7, 33453, amended. The first 2 sentences of section 3453 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, are further amended to read as follows:

The commissioner is authorized to appoint a dog recorder or recorders in unorganized territories. Said recorders shall list all dogs 4 6 months old or over, owned or kept by any inhabitants on Jahuary 1st, setting the number and sex thereof opposite the names of their respective owners and keepers.
