STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Permitting Partial Payments at Times other than August and December for Operation of Regional Vocational Technical Centers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3455, amended. The first sentence of section 3455 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 49 of chapter 544 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

All apportionments Apportionments to administrative units, academies and institutes under this Title, unless specifically directed by statute, shall be made annually in the following manner:

An amount not to exceed 2/3 of the estimated subsidy shall be paid on or after August 15th, or as much thereof as is available, and the balance shall be due and payable in the month of December; partial payments may be made to regional vocational-technical centers at such times and in such amounts as the State Board of Education may authorize.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Since such units are subsidized at 2/3 of the expenditure, it is essential that aid be given more often than once a year. No additional appropriation is requested, but permission to make payments from funds which may be available is sought.
