AN ACT Relating to Tuition for Pupils Attending School Outside of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 1292, amended. The 5th sentence of section 1292 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 47 of chapter 544 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Any administrative unit shall pay tuition for any student who with parent or guardian resides in said administrative unit and who attends an approved school of secondary grade in another state or country; or for any student who attends an approved school of secondary grade in another state when said school specializes in the correction of physical defects and when by reason of a disability the individual requires a specialized type of training available in said school but not obtainable in any approved secondary school in the State of Maine.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall be retroactive to September 1, 1968.
