AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Examiners of Podiatrists.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 32, § 3603, amended. The last sentence of section 3603 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

Members of the Board of Registration in Medicine, the secretary of said board and the podiatrist appointed by the Governor, as provided in section 3601, shall each receive ~~\$5~~ \$25 for every day actually spent in the performance of the duties imposed upon them by this chapter, and in addition thereto necessary traveling and hotel expenses actually incurred, to be certified by the chairman and secretary.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This Act requires no appropriation of state funds as the compensation is paid by fees collected under this chapter.
