STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Vocational and Technical Institute in Waterville.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Vocational and Technical Institute; appropriation for. The Department of Education shall establish an area vocational and technical institute at Waterville, to provide specialized post-secondary vocational and technical training for high school graduates, vocational and technical training for those who have reached their 18th birthday but who have not been graduated from high school, and for adults who give evidence of special aptitude or need and who desire specialized or refresher training for employment in service of trade, industry or commerce.
- Sec. 2. Gifts. The Department of Education is authorized and empowered to receive such gifts and donations, either from public or private sources, as may be offered unconditionally.
- Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$250,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 and \$250,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.
